

German Minor

The German Department offers coursework in language, culture, literature, and linguistics. Entering students take a placement test during the summer before their arrival to determine where to begin the program.

Requirements

Students majoring in other subjects are welcome to minor in German. Six courses taught in GERM are required (beginning with GERM 1502 or GERM 1511), at least three of which need to be at a level above 3000. At least one course should be a level V course. Students also have the option of taking one GERM course taught in English and counting it towards the minor.
